**Treasurer report –**

- ✓ Spring fees to the State haven't been paid yet.
- ✓ Lanny hasn't paid his late registration fees but he's helping out with painting the fields to compensate for it.

**SUSA –**

- ✓ AGM will be held on Thursday, May 28<sup>th</sup> 2009 at 6:30 pm at Boulevard Home Furnishings instead of May 19<sup>th</sup> as originally planned. A mass email needs to be sent to coaches ASAP mentioning all the positions that are open for re-election this year (President, RCL VP, Iron County and Virgin Valley KICKS VP, Director of Fields and Scheduling).
- ✓ ODP – Not enough players have responded for friendlies which will be held June 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> in Orem. Program is struggling a little. We might have to send fewer teams and maybe hand pick players who haven't registered in order to send up competitive teams. Jeff suggests that we take baby steps and send only 2 teams (one for boys and one for girls). Let's target a certain age group (94/95). We need a quick response to see if it is possible.
- ✓ Coaching courses:  
"E" course will be held week of July 6<sup>th</sup> (Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday)  
"D" course will be held July 27<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup> and August 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> (3h on weeknights and 6h on Saturdays)  
On mass email for AGM, reminder that every team is required to have a licensed coach (E minimum). General consensus, we need to enforce the waivers for coaches.
- ✓ Sports medicine class – Due to the increase in injuries on the pitch, Kyle suggests that a class be taught to educate coaches how to deal with injuries, something like First Aid class maybe.
- ✓ Storage shed – We need to buy racks for the storage shed to organize it better. Danny has been given the go ahead to buy some.
- ✓ Great feedback from high schools principals regarding the signs SUSA put up at their field.

**TOURNAMENT –** Kim has sent the paperwork for Winter Showcase 2010. If we become a district, we should be able to keep both tournaments (Invitational and Winter Showcase). Let's explore the idea of KICKS sponsoring one tournament and RCL sponsoring the other one.

Kim would like to use our local certified referee assigner (Teresa Ortiz). Board agrees.

**INDOOR SOCCER –** Dragons have registered 2 teams for indoor soccer summer league and are inviting other teams to register.

**KICKS –**

- ✓ There were 33 registrations the day of Kite Festival. Danny suggests that we have another registration day (at Boulevard perhaps?).
- ✓ City requests we have permission from business owners to put banners around town.
